Appliance Care Instructions (Occlusal Splints, Dentures, Partial Dentures & Retainers)(

- Bring your appliance to every appointment, including your cleaning appointments.
- Clean your appliance everyday with a soft tooth brush and antibacterial soap.
- Do not leave appliance soaking in cleaner all day or overnight, only soak for a few minutes even if manufacturer's packing states that you can. These cleaners can cause your appliance to become very brittle and chip, tear or break easily.
- Never soak your appliance in mouthwash, it contains alcohol and can make appliance brittle.
- Never use tooth paste because it is abrasive and can scratch appliance.
- Never leave dentures or partial dentures in your mouth while sleeping.
- Store appliance in its case near your tooth brush.
- Never wrap it in a napkin or place in your pocket.
- If you notice your appliance has become loose, tight fitting or if you feel soreness, call for appointment.
- Never try to adjust your appliance yourself.
- Keep appliance away from pets, they seem to like them.
