Fillings or Bonding Post-op Information

If your lip and tongue are still numb after your filling, avoid eating until the area feels normal again. If you notice a difference in your bite, please call to schedule a bite refinement.

You may experience mild sensitivity in the area of the filling or the injection site. You may experience limited opening of the jaw if your filling was in the lower arch. This is a completely normal response. However, if your tooth becomes more sensitive to cold and hot or a spontaneous tooth ache occurs, your nerve may be responding and you may require root canal therapy.
